CALL TO ORDER

Chair, Gunta Vitins, called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm on February 22, 2021.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The Board discussed any perceived conflicts of interest with the proposed agenda items.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

It was MOVED by Jon Krahn and SECONDED that the agenda be adopted as amended.

1.0 OPERATIONS

1.1 Period 3 Pricing

After the Period 3 Pricing Order was distributed to BC producers and graders on February 8, 2021, there was some confusion regarding BC Egg's pricing methodology. To clarify the pricing process, a Producer Pricing Methodology document was drafted for review by the Board and EIAC. The Board reviewed the document and feedback from the EIAC, and discussed a path forward.

1.2 SE Update

A public health notice has been distributed by PHAC warning of a SE outbreak in Nova Scotia and Newfoundland due to the consumption of eggs. The Board discussed this announcement and the potential impacts to producers.

1.3 Sibling Transfers

BC Egg's current transfer assessment policy on Sibling Transfers may be more restrictive than BCFIRB's directive. Historical details regarding the policy and clarification from BCFIRB were provided for discussion.

Action: Staff was directed to bring an amending order to the next meeting and clarification on the impacts to affected producers.

2.0 GOVERNANCE

2.1 AGM Voting Procedure

The 2021 AGM will be conducted virtually and voting will be different than at in person meetings. Clarification on the on-line voting process was presented for information. The voting process will be clearly explained to producers attending the AGM prior to voting.
