

**AMENDING ORDER #001  
TO THE  
CONSOLIDATED ORDER OF DECEMBER 31, 2023**

**MADE BY  
THE BRITISH COLUMBIA EGG MARKETING BOARD  
ON JUNE 26, 2024**

The British Columbia Egg Marketing Board orders as follows:

1. The EXW definition in Part I of the Consolidated Order of December 31, 2023 is repealed and replaced with:

“**EXW**” means Ex Works (EXW) as defined in the Incoterms 2020. The seller must make the goods available, suitably packaged, at the specified place, usually the seller’s place of business. The buyer is responsible for (a) loading the goods onto a vehicle; (b) transport; and (c) all costs arising after collection of the goods. The purchaser bears the risk of loss after the goods are received by the purchaser at the seller’s place of business.

2. Section 5 of Part IX of the Consolidated Order of December 31, 2023 is added as follows:

(3) Where a Grading Station Operator receives regulated product from a Registered Producer, the Grading Station Operator and the Registered Producer shall be deemed to have contracted for the purchase and sale of regulated product in accordance with all applicable requirements and obligations specified in the Consolidated Order.

(4)The BCEMB, as a regulatory agency, is acting as a facilitating intermediary in the payment of producers for the regulated product.

(5)The BCEMB does not act as an agent on behalf of the producer or the grader.

(6)The BCEMB assumes no responsibility with respect to the merchantability of any regulated product.

3. This Order comes into effect June 26, 2024.
