Small Lot Producers may sell ungraded eggs directly to end users (those who will actually be eating the eggs). These sales can be made through farm gate sales or at farmers markets.

Small Lot Producers are not permitted to sell ungraded eggs to food retail establishments or food service operations. Food retail establishments include grocery stores, convenience stores and other retailers that sell food and beverages directly to consumers. Food service operations include businesses and non-profit organizations such as restaurants, institutions, hotels and caterers that provide food and beverage services directly to consumers. Eggs sold to these types of organizations must be graded through a Registered Shell Egg Station. Small Lot Producers cannot sell eggs to a Registered Shell Egg Station.
